The New York State Department of Health has a Southern Tier Cancer Services Program of Broome, Chenango, and Tioga Counties. Call 607-873-1500. Their mission is to reach all uninsured/under-insured residents in these counties (who qualify) to provide free breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screenings to reduce cancer rates in our counties.

The Age-Appropriate, Risk-Based Screenings offered by the CSP are:

- Mammograms and clinical breast exams for breast cancer.
- Pap tests and pelvic exams for cervical cancer.
- Take home fecal tests (FIT or FOBT) for colorectal cancer.

Pain Control

Cancer pain should be addressed quickly and aggressively. The treating physician is the first contact, but other resources are available:

Palliative Care is a program with **Lourdes Hospital**, located in Binghamton, NY. Palliative care specializes in relieving the symptoms and stress of serious illness. Symptoms may be physical, emotional, or spiritual. The goal is to improve quality of life for you and your family. Palliative care may be appropriate at any point in an illness, from diagnosis on, and it can be provided at the same time as treatment that is meant to cure you.

Working closely with your primary physician, we provide:

- Expert treatment of pain and other symptoms
- Guidance with difficult treatment choices
- Emotional and spiritual support for you and your family
- Coordination of care
- Close communication and compassionate care
- Advance Care Planning

An **Employee Assistance Program** (EAP) is typically offered through your employer, and can provide resources available to you in your area. Contact your human resource department to see what benefits are provided.

Genetic Counseling

Genetic counseling for cancer involves having a trained genetic counselor help you and your family understand your inherited cancer risk. Inherited cancer risk may be passed from parent to child. The genetic counselor explains available genetic tests. He or she can also offer information about cancer screening, prevention, and treatment options and provide support.

Older Adults:

Cancer becomes more common as people get older. When an older person undergoes cancer treatment, the support s/he needs may relate as much to aging as to the cancer itself. There are local agencies that can provide support to older adults.
